OSHA - Recertification and New Stuff for Annual Training

Presented by: George Bailey, DDS, MPH


Dr. Bailey holds a Doctor of Dental Surgery from the UMKC School of Dentistry, as well as a Masters in Public Health from Saint Louis University. He has also completed a one year internship with the Office of Rural Health and Primary Care in the Department of Health and Senior Services of the State of Missouri. He currently practices in Pulaski County.



OSHA is the governmental agency responsible for the safety of workers in the workplace. While this agency is no longer the specter for dental offices that it once was, it still has the power to enter any workplace that it has reason to believe to be unsafe and determine that all that can reasonably be done by the employer for employee safety is being accomplished. One of these employer's duties is the annual retraining requirement for all employees. This two hour course is aimed primary at ancillary office staff that may handle both hazardous chemicals or potentially infected materials. The first portion of the course will follow OSHA mandates as to retraining protocols. This will be required materials following OSHA recommendations. The last segment of the course will focus on new problems that are emerging in the dental workplace and on new potential foci of this government agency as they seek to protect the dental worker. The aim of this course is not only to enable the safety of dental workers, but to present to some degree a protective regimen for dental offices to follow.

OBJECTIVES:

- The relationship of OSHA to the safety of the employee
- What are the employer's responsibilities
- What is mandated by OSHA as to the handling of hazardous chemicals and potentially infectious materials
- What are universal precautions
- What are the proper protocol in the event of an untoward happening that involves employee safety
- What are the emerging dangers to employee safety in the dental workplace
