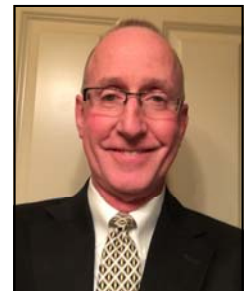
The OSHA Bloodborne Pathogen Standard requires that employers who have employees with occupational exposure to blood and other potential infectious material provide training for those employees annually. This training must take place within 12 months of the previous training on the standard. The OSHA standard contains fifteen elements that must be addressed in the training. The major exception is that the standard does not require an annual review of the employer's exposure control plan. This portion of the requirement will need to occur in the participants' individual office setting. However, a discussion of the elements required in all plans will be included. The course will provide 1 CE hour for the BBP and 2 CE hours for the Infection Control.

Objectives:

- Be aware of safety issues involved in dental care
- Be able to apply modern infection control principals
- Be knowledgeable about requirements of the OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standards
- Be able to critically analyze different methods for instrument decontamination
